





IN 2015 THE AURORA HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF '75 HAD THEIR 40TH CLASS REUNION. AT THAT TIME THE CLASS ESTABLISHED THE "AURORA HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF '75 SCHOLARSHIP". TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS WAS DONATED TO FUND THE SCHOLARSHIP FOR A TEN-YEAR PERIOD WITH \$1,000 GOING TO A SENIOR EACH YEAR. THE SCHOLARSHIP IS AWARDED TO AN AURORA GRADUATING SENIOR WHO PLANS TO CONTINUE THEIR EDUCATION AT A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR A TECHNICAL/TRADE SCHOOL. Our TRADE Scholarship Program Did you know that the Aurora Alumni Association has created a new scholarship program for kids going into a TRADE! In 2019, a new scholarship was created to offer scholarships to graduating seniors going into a Trade or Vocation. Ruth Griffin Tuttle, AHS '65 created this program after attending many "awards ceremonies" for the Aurora Alumni Association, The Aurora Schools Foundation, and for her 6 grandchildren that attend the Aurora City Schools. Realizing that scholarships were being awarded only to college bound students, Mrs, Tuttle created this program. She is a practicing Interior Designer who valued her relationships with carpenters, plumbers, electricians, stone masons...THE TRADES! In 2017, Jean Doubrava Harris, AHS '66, was inducted into The Aurora High School Hall of Fame. Mrs. Tuttle discussed the idea of a Trade program with Mrs. Harris at the ceremony. Mrs. Harris reached in her purse and wrote a check for \$1,000....this created the program and the first scholarship!

Between Mrs. Tuttle and Mrs. Harris, they have raised \$75,000 for this program! Sadly, Chuck Harris, AHS '65, passed away this past summer. His memorial wish was to donate to the AAA Trade Scholarship Program. Many memorial contributions were received in his memory.

Our MISSION is to raise at least \$150,000 to create a "permanent scholarship investment" to award Trade Scholarships for years to come. We hope to give a scholarship to every student that applies! Since 2020, Trade Scholarships have been awarded to two future plumbers, an electrician, an auto mechanic, a diesel truck mechanic, a Chef, and a National Park Ranger!
